# Parenting Strategies to Develop a Growth Mindset

I have a daughter who dislikes challenges. She'd rather give up than persevere. This is probably hugely affected by her sensory processing disorder and ADHD. How, I don't really know. But I do know that she **does not have** what professor Angela Duckworth calls <u>grit</u> and author Carol Dweck calls it a <u>growth</u> mindset. Or at least it's hidden somewhere.

She's living with a **fixed mindset**. This is when you believe that people are either born smart or not; that talents, intelligence, and personality can't be changed. But we know from decades of research that this is simply not true. Our <u>brains are amazingly malleable</u>, even as adults.

Now don't get me wrong, I don't need my daughter to get straight As or a perfect score, that's not it at all. What I care about is my daughter's life. Having a growth mindset is essential for a successful life. In all areas. (although kids with a growth mindset do better in school than their peers without).

My heart's desire is that my daughter starts to see her potential by adopting a growth mindset. I want her to believe she can learn anything, grow in areas of challenge, and work hard to solve any problem.








### Defibrillator Reminder
