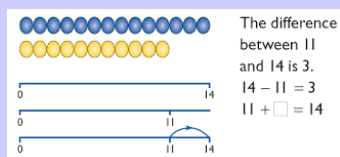
### Maths

Partition numbers into hundreds, tens and units.

Read and write 3 digit numbers and be able to compare and estimate.

To be able find missing numbers in addition and subtraction calculations

Mentally add and subtract numbers.

Find  $62 - 8$ .

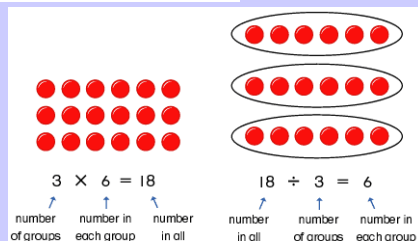


Subtracting 8 is the same as subtracting 10 and adding 2.

**Step 1** Subtract 10 from 62.

**Step 2** Add 2 to the result.

So,  $62 - 8 = 54$ .
