After three weeks, we would like to collect in the pupils' books (week beginning 26th September) to see how their project is progressing. <p><u>Roman food</u></p> <p>Research, design and produce a Roman menu. Can you cook one of the dishes, take photos and write a review?</p>	<p><u>Weapon Creation</u></p> <p>At times, Romans could be a blood-thirsty lot. Can you design a weapon for the soldiers to use during the invasion of Britain? Explain the features you have drawn.</p>	<p><u>Legion Standards</u></p> <p>Research different Roman Legion insignia, draw and label or make your favourite one.</p>
<p><u>Mosaic Making</u></p> <p>Create your own symmetrical Roman mosaic using materials of your own choice. Can you be inspired by actual mosaics that have been found?</p>	<p><u>Model-Making</u></p> <p>Design and make a Roman related model. Perhaps you could use local Roman remains to inspire you to create a model villa for example.</p>	<p><u>A to Z of Romans</u></p> <p>Write down a word related to the Romans for each letter of the alphabet. Then write a sentence about each one to explain it.</p>
<p><u>Story Time</u></p> <p>Write an imaginative story about the life of a child in Ancient Rome. How was their life different to ours? Don't forget to include a problem and resolution.</p>	<p><u>Roman News Report</u></p> <p>Research a key event from Roman history and turn your research into a news report. You could either film this or record it! You could magpie ideas on how to do this from Horrible Histories.</p>	<p><u>Roman Empire</u></p> <p>Draw a map of the Roman Empire. Label the map with the Roman country names and the current country names.</p>
