## BUILDING CHANGES

As you are very much aware we have building works at the moment to accommodate the additional growth in primary aged children anticipated on the estate. You will also be aware that the building doesn't yet look finished!

We have more children starting at the school in September than Y6 leaving in July so we do need more classrooms than are currently available. So we have some temporary plans in place until the building is completed towards the end of the Autumn Term.

The new hall extension is due to be finished in August so this will become a temporary class base, as will the current staffroom... staff will relocate to cabins.

What does this mean for your children? It means that every child will be educated in the main building but three of our rooms will have a temporary change of use. It won't affect the quality of their education or their curriculum entitlement.

It does however mean that there will be movement of class bases when we gain ownership of the new extension! Those in the current staffroom will be moved to one of our brand new classrooms and a few of the other classrooms will need to be "jigged" about. Whilst this is not ideal, it is the best solution to the situation we find ourselves in and the project manager has allowed us a decent budget to ensure the "temporary" bases are kitted out with all the equipment that we need.



## LUNCHES AT THE END OF TERM

So that the hall extension is ready for us in August we have agreed for the builders to start work on the "knocking through" before the end of term. Obviously this leaves us without a hall space - but we have a solution! We will be gaining a marquee for the children to eat their lunches in and to be used as a learning space.

Please be patient with us whilst these changes take place. Wendy, our cook, will still be providing lunch for the children though the menu will need to be slightly amended.



# CLASS STRUCTURES

This year we will start with 3  $\times$  Reception classes and 2 classes for each of the other year groups. Please be mindful that as the school continues to grow we may well need to restructure our classes during the year.

# MUSIC LESSONS FROM SEPT 16 ALL PUPILS IN <u>CURRENT</u> YEARS 2/3/4/5

Would your child like to learn to play a musical instrument?

- Instruments include; keyboards, guitar, saxophone, clarinets & flutes
- Lessons are during the school day and last for 20 minutes
  - Lessons cost £5 per session (£50 per term)
- Flutes, clarinets and saxophones are available to hire from the Music
   Service at £25 per term.
- Each child will be given a diary which should be filled in regularly by the parent/carer and is a way of communication between the teacher and school.

Children commit to learning an instrument a term at a time. We require half a term's notice should they wish to change/stop an instrument ie. we would need to know by October half term if they are stopping in January.

Please could you return the form in a named envelope to the office by Monday 11<sup>th</sup> July). If you would like to make alternative payment arrangements please talk to me in confidence.

If your child is already learning to play an instrument, please also complete the form to confirm you wish them to continue.


