<u>Maths</u> Tack 1

<u>Task 1</u>

Help an adult at home measure out some ingredients when they are cooking. You could help measure how much something weighs or how much liquid there is in a jug. Write down what you measure.

<u>Task 2</u>

Do you know your number bonds to 10 (e.g. 6 and 4, 3 and 7)? Make a poster to help Reception children learn their number bonds. Remember to make your poster bright, colourful and easy to read.

<u>**Task 3</u>** Create a self-portrait using natural materials such as leaves, sticks and pebbles, fruit and vegetables.</u>

<u>**Task 4</u>** Make your own castle! You can be as creative as you like! What materials will you use?</u>

<u>Task 5</u> Find out about a celebration from another religion. When do they celebrate? How do they celebrate? Why do they celebrate?

What did Norwich used to be like in the past? What was the high street like?
