Maths

Task 1 We have been learning to add and subtract on a number line. Find a fun way to teach someone else. Perhaps you could design a poster with pictures or record a video where you explain it? You might want to write some instructions.

Task 2 Go for a 5 minute walk. How many parked cars do you see? How could you effectively record your findings? Are there some colours which are more popular than others?

Art and Design

Task 3 Design your own crown. Try to include as many 2D shapes as you can in your design, but remember it needs to have a clear pattern.

Task 4 You are having a street party to celebrate the Coronation! Design your ideal party dish. You may decide to draw and colour a picture, paint it or maybe even make a 3D model on a paper plate!

Task 5 Read three different poems. What do you like about them? Is there anything you didn't like? Record your ideas in your homework book.

Task 6 How are your research skills? Use a non-fiction book to find 10 facts that you didn't already know. Which parts of the book were helpful when looking for information?

Writing

Task 7 Write about one thing that you did in the half term holidays. For a challenge, try to include expanded noun phrases (tall, green tree).

Task 8 Choose your favourite character from your reading book. Can you write a paragraph to describe this character using three adjective lists and similes?

History

Task 9 What was the Diamond Jubilee? Can you find out three ways that it was celebrated? Log on to Purple Mash, search 'Jubilee' and create a postcard and show what you have learnt.
