Maths

Task 1 Write a shopping list of at least 3 things and find out their prices in the shop or online. Can you add them up? What change would you have if you paid with £5 note?

Task 2 Find 10 things you would like to measure in your house and fill out a table to record them. You could choose to measure how high up you sleep, how many millilitres are in a ketchup bottle, how tall you are in centimetres and metres, the longest banana in your fruit bowl. The list is up to you!

Reading

Task 5 Read a book by an author you haven't read before. What do you like about the words they use? Tell a grown-up what you think.

Task 6 Look through a poetry book for a short poem you like. Can you learn some or all the poem to read aloud in class? You might draw a text map to help you! Copy or print the poem in your book and decorate it with things in the poem.

Science and Technology

Task 3 What is a habitat? Choose a woodland animal. What can you find out about its habitat? Include where it shelters and what it eats.

Task 4 Go for a walk with an adult. What animals do you see? What are they doing? Where do you think they live and why?

Writing

Task 7 Imagine taking a journey in a snowstorm. Can you describe the difficult trip? For a challenge, use -ly words to add detail.

Task 8 Write about one thing that happened in the Christmas holidays. Can you use conjunctions such as *but, then, because, that, if, when*?

Art

Task 9 Find an artist who has painted or created a sculpture of a pussycat. Who is the artist and when were they working? What is special about their work? How is it different from other art you have seen? Create your own version of their art - if it's a sculpture, record it with a photo stuck into your book.
