

On foot

Queen's Hill Primary has been built to serve the new village of Queen's Hill currently under construction in West Costessey, west of Norwich city centre. The development is still within the building stage. There are currently three exits to the school, the main one off Kestrel Avenue, secondary on Fieldfare Way and a pedestrian only through the back playground. There are separate pedestrian and vehicular entrances.. There is emergency vehicle access to the rear of the building. The school opened in September 2008 for Reception to Y6 children and nursery children started in January 2009. There have been several stages of building works to expand the school. It will officially open with its maximum capacity of 630 in July 2017.

School opens at 8.30am and finish at 3pm. A breakfast club starts at 7.45 a.m. which approximately 30 children attend. There are a variety of after school cubs until approx 4 pm each day.

Stakeholders can walk to school and enter using two main entrances to the side and rear of the school. Parents are encouraged to walk with their children and come into school for the first 10 minutes of each day. Doors are locked at 8.40. Any parents still in the building leave through the front visitors entrance on Kestrel Avenue.

The school is situated approximately 5 miles from the city centre. The closest pub, eatery and supermarket is approximately 1 mile away from the school.



There is a bus stop directly outside the school.

By bike



Children are encouraged to cycle to school. Children in Year 5receieve cycle training funded by the school. Cycles and helmets are provided by the school for children to use during the training if they do not have the correct equipment. The school has ample cycle parking spaces at the side of the school and at the front visitor entrance. If children park at the front visitor entrance they are required to walk to the side or rear entrance. There is also space for adult/staff cycle parking which is covered, adjacent to the kitchen area.

By bus



Park and Ride provide a service near to the Norfolk Show Ground which is approximately 4 miles from our school.

There is a bus stop directly outside the school. Buses run frequently to and from the bus stop from and to Norwich City centre.

By train



Norwich city train station is located in the city centre. From there a taxi ride takes approximately 30 minutes to our school costing around £13. Alternatively you can catch a bus from the city centre to a bus stop directly outside the school. You could cycle from Norwich train station. This is a distance of 13 miles and would take approximately 41 minutes.

By Car



To find us by car enter the following post codes into the SAT NAV system. NR8 5AZ or NR8 5FT. These post codes take you directly to the two main car parks. There is ample parking available. If the car park is full, off road parking is available directly outside the school on Fieldfare way. There are no permit restrictions. Just avoid the yellow lines.
