



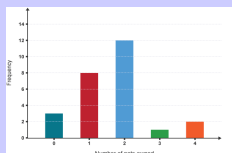
Year 4 Summer Term 2017

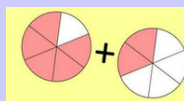
Maths



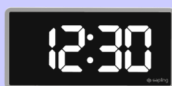
Solve comparison, sum and difference problems using information presented in bar charts, pictograms, tables and other graphs.

$$\frac{3}{8} + \frac{4}{8}$$

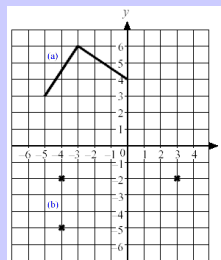


Find fractions of an amount. Add and subtract fractions

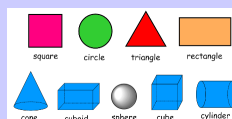
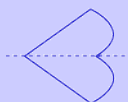


Tell the time
