Complete a detailed sketch of a mini beast or animal living in its habitat.	Make a bird food ball for an outdoor space and write a set of instructions to share with others.	Draw a food chain for a woodland animal.
Complete a mini beast survey. Record the amount of mini beasts (caterpillars, snails, slugs, centipedes, worms, spiders, woodlice, ants, ladybirds, beetles, butterflies etc) you can find in certain areas - an area of the park, an area of the wood, an area of grass etc.	Create an information leaflet about an animal of your choice. Include awesome facts about the animal, it's habitat, where it comes from, the food it eats etc.	Describe the habitat for each of these animals: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Shark- Lion- Ladybird- Camel
Create a nature wordsearch.	Complete a detailed sketch of a leaf, flower or other plant.	Either draw or print an image of a minibeast and label its body parts. Make sure you research what each part of its body is/does.
