What to expect, when?

Growth Mindset

We are continuing to encourage the children to be independent and have a 'Passion for Learning' through promoting our 'Growth Mindset characters', they include: Charlie Challenge, Connor Concentration, Ronnie Reflection, Timmy Teamwork, Helen Have-a-go, Immy Imagination, Percy Perseverance, Kate Curiosity.

Our Curriculum: Communication and Language (C&L)

We are learning to share ideas in detail, use different tenses accurately, act in role and develop a narrative. We are also playing word games and learning about rhyming words.

Our Curriculum Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

The children are continuing their PATHS lessons (Promoting Alternative Thinking Strategies) that help them develop their understanding of emotions and feelings. We are also practising sharing and working in a team.

Our Curriculum: Physical Development (PD)

In PE lessons this term we are working on different multi-skills outside such as, throwing javelins!

Our Curriculum: Literacy (L)

We are continuing to apply our phonics knowledge to write and read sentences. Some children are trying to up-level their writing by using exciting vocabulary, connectives, openers and punctuation. Every term we learn a story by memory to develop our story writing language, this term it is 'The Three Little Pigs'.

Our Curriculum: Maths (M)

This term we are solving addition and subtraction problems and representing our maths by recording number sentences. We are exploring capacity, weight and height and putting objects in order. We will continue to practice recognising and ordering numerals.

Our Curriculum: Understanding the World (UTW)

In Geography we are learning about how ways of life differ around the world. In History we are learning about Kings and Queens. In Technology we are learning about E-safety and how electricity is used in school. In Science we are comparing different animals and plants and learning about lifecycles.

Our Curriculum: Expressive Art and Design (EAD)

In our Creative Arts lessons we are learning how to use different tools safely and effectively. This term we are expressing our thoughts and feelings through design technology and music.
