Express Yourself!

English

We will be studying a range of different texts this term including: Shakespeare 's Romeo and Juliet; The Highwayman (classic poetry); and Pie Corbett's 'The Nightmare Man'. We will explore range of different genres such as: writing persuasive texts, internal monologues, diary writing, newspaper reports and short story writing. As part of our history topic, we will focus upon The West African slave trade and Benin and the pupils will have the opportunity to develop research and note taking skills. They will also take part in a range of debates in Humanities and RE. To support your child with their learning, we would encourage you to practise writing, spelling and grammar @ BBC Revisewise, www.crickweb.co.uk, http://resources.woodlands-junior.kent.sch.uk/interactive/literacy2.htm or google Coxhoe Primary school for even more activities. When listening to your child read, ask them questions about the text (including the meaning of different vocabulary) and ensure that they have an opportunity to read and/or listen to more challenging texts. Your child will come home with a bookmark with reading comprehension prompt questions.
