English: We will be studying a range of different texts this term including: The Arrival by Shaun Tan, The Spider and The Fly (classic poetry); The Day of Ahmed's Secret and Hurricane. We will explore a range of different genres such as: writing persuasive texts, journal writing, writing a descriptive setting, recounts and short story writing. We will also being using drama to deepen our understanding about character and motives within a text. As part of our Geography topic, we will focus upon natural disasters and the pupils will have the opportunity to develop research and note taking skills. They will also take part in a range of debates in Humanities and RE. 

Compare fractions, decimals and percentages. Solve problems involving the calculation of percentages e.g. 15% of 360.


Read and plot coordinates.

oping our animation skills. In Design and Technology, we will be investigating, designing and making our

own vehicles. In Humanities, we will learn about natural disasters and in science we will learn about forces.
