Maths

Task 1 Can you remember written methods for addition and subtraction? Ask someone to write some calculations for you to answer.

Task 2 We can use the inverse calculation to check our answers. For example, if you want to check an addition calculation then you use the subtraction or to check a multiplication then you complete a division. Use this method to complete and then check some calculations.

Reading

Task 5 You are going to be the teacher! Read your reading book and then write some guided reading questions for someone else at home to answer.

Task 6 We have spoken about the blurb on the back of the book and how we use it. Write a blurb for your reading book so that I can guess what book you have been reading.

Science

Task 3 We will be studying life cycles of different animals. Have a look into the life cycle of a frog. Show what you have learnt through a labelled diagram.

Task 4 We have looked at materials and their properties. Have a look at some of the toys and objects at home. What are they made of? Why are they made of that material and not a different material? What would happen if they were made of something different?

Writing

Task 7 We have written lots of stories recently. Become an author and write your own story! Remember that there needs to be a problem in the middle that can be solved by one of the characters.

Task 8 This term we are creating a non-chronological report about dinosaurs. Choose an animal to research and create a report telling me lots of information about the animal.

Geography

Task 9 Later in the term we will be studying how areas have changed and the part that humans have played in them changing.
