



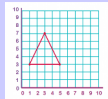

## English

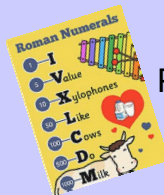
During Summer Term 1, children will be completing non-fiction writing based around natural disasters. This includes writing newspaper reports and explanation texts. In Summer Term 2, children will continue linking their learning to 'Our Amazing Planet' by writing both fictional and non-fictional pieces related to Earth & Space and Stone Age. Within the Stone Age, we will be reading 'Stig of the Dump' by Clive King—please feel free to share this with your child at home. Spellings will be sent home weekly so please support your child to learn these and apply them within their written work.

Plotting coordinates and translating shapes on an 'x' and 'y' axis

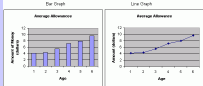


Fractions: converting improper fractions, simplifying fractions and adding, subtracting and multiplying fractions



Roman numerals

Drawing and finding information on bar and line graphs



Recapping area and perimeter, properties of 2D and 3D shapes, missing angles and comparing fractions, decimals and percentages



Time—telling the time and converting between 12 hour and 24 hour clock

During the Summer term, pupils will continue to learn the violin during sessions on a Monday afternoon.

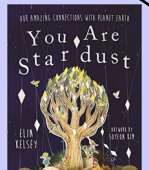


## PSHE and RE

Pupils will have weekly PATHS sessions this term. We will also be learning about Christianity and Hinduism over the year.

## Topic

Our whole school topic this term is 'Our Amazing Planet'. In summer term 1, children will be learning about natural disasters (volcanoes and earthquakes) and including this learning within their written work. In Art, children will be developing their skills and creating a final piece of work based on the book 'You are Stardust' by Elin Kelsey. In summer 2, children will be learning all about Earth and Space. In particular, the relative movement of planets within the solar system. In addition to this, we will also be covering Stone Age to Iron Age history.



Thank you for your on-going support at home! Please continue to listen to your child read (remember to record new words in their diary) and carry out maths activities with them **at least four times per week**. Optional maths worksheets will be sent home weekly for your child to complete and these will contribute towards their Marvellous Maths stamps. Home Learning will continue to be set and collected in weekly (Thursday). Your child will receive spellings every Friday. Maths activities, that are relevant to current topics, will be set on Manga High and these will also count towards the weekly Marvellous Maths stamps.
