WELCOME BACK

We hope that you had a wonderful summer - what great weather we had! We now have over 500 children on roll with more children arriving as new houses are sold. If you are new to Queen's Hill we hope you soon feel part of our community, the Friends of QHPS would love for you to join them and if any parents or carers have capacity to volunteer in school we would love to hear from you. We would welcome volunteers to listen to readers, work in the library, support in class or help with sports teams. All volunteers will need a DBS check - if you are interested please speak to your child's class teacher.

We have an open door policy but sometimes issues need more than a conversation in passing to be resolved. If you have any concerns please make an appointment to see your child's classteacher. Should you still be concerned then an appointment should be made to see the Year Leader: Reception - Miss Compton; Year 1 - Mrs Carpenter (nee Allen); Year 2 - Mrs Walden and Mrs Moore; Year 3 - Ms Taylor; Year 4 - Mr Jones; Year 5 - Mr Emmens; Year 6 - Miss Kerrison and Mrs White. Sometimes you may want to discuss the issue further with the Phase Leader (Reception and Nursery- Miss Compton; Year 1 and 2 (KS1) - Mrs Carpenter and Mr Jones for KS2 (Years 3-6).

We strongly advise parents and carers to come in and voice their concerns and worries in person rather than discussing school issues on social networking sites such as Facebook.

You may have already seen Mr Cross, our new Assistant Head Teacher, around the school. Mr Cross is responsible for Curriculum Design and oversees provision in Early Years and KS1; Miss Kerrison is now Assistant Head Teacher with responsibility for Behaviours for Learning (including attendance) and oversees provision in KS2.

STAFF TRAINING

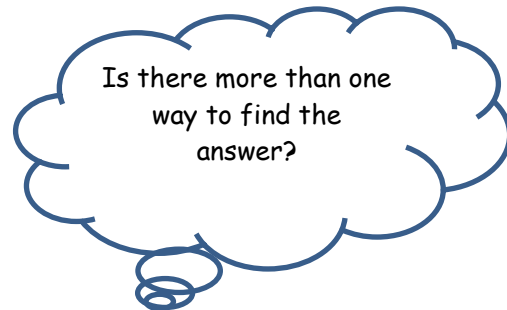
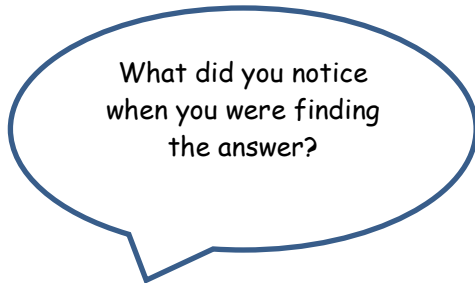
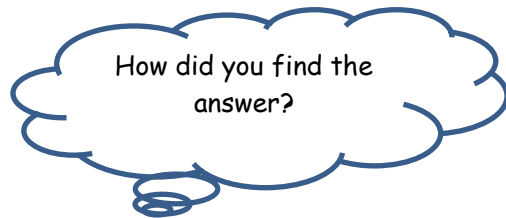
Staff have received training on the first two days of term before the children started to ensure they have up-to-date safeguarding training and "Step on" and "Step Up" training which helps to de-escalate situations when children present challenging behaviour. In addition staff have developed strategies to ensure they are challenging all children. Over the next couple of weeks the teachers have training on delivering PE alongside weekly maths training.

Whole-school focus: Reasoning

This half-term we will be developing children's mathematical reasoning skills. Reasoning is one of the key aims of maths and is strongly linked to children's maths thinking. Teachers will give children a chance to reason daily in maths and other areas of the curriculum.

There are many ways that you can help your child with reasoning at home. When talking about numbers or doing calculations together, you could ask your child one of the questions below. Look out for the puzzle pack that your child will come home with next week to help them carry on their reasoning work at home and earn their marvellous maths stamps!
