What was meant to be a routine operation turned into a 12 hour ordeal, especially for my wife who was 8 months pregnant. The operation left me heavily disabled and I was even told I'd never walk again. As I laid in my hospital bed, I thought, 'I'll prove them wrong.'
I had to retire from all work and couldn't drive but through the love and support of my family, I did walk again, fathered another child and even went to a Wrestlemania 35 in New York.
Now I want to leave a legacy, especially for my kids. My plan is to raise funds for schools to play and educate

themselves with Lego.


Lego was instrumental in helping my recovery and I want others to experience the joy and freedom of Lego. So I hope to implement Lego in schools. Simple!!
