

Year 2 Summer Term 2019

'A Drop in the Ocean'

English

This term in English, we will continue to develop children's writing across a range of genre, including story writing, information texts and poetry. We will start the term by writing responses to letters we have kindly received from year 2 children in a London school. We will then be writing fact-files on the city of Norwich, before completing a piece of fiction writing to develop the children's creative writing. Daily reading sessions with your child will continue to take place. These will increasingly focus on developing children's comprehension skills.

Maths

This term, we will be focusing on:

- Reading scales in divisions of ones, twos, fives and tens.
- Solving unfamiliar word problems that involve more than one step.

"Which has the most biscuits, 4 packets of biscuits with 5 in each packet or 3 packets of biscuits with 10 in each packet?"

 Recalling multiplication and division facts for 2, 5 and 10 and use them to solve simple problems,

Topic

During the first half-term, we'll be finding out more about the fine city of Norwich. The children will be improving their local geographical knowledge, creating some art inspired by key landmarks in the city and developing their mapping skills.

After half-term, we will be looking at some of the coastal towns around Norfolk, exploring their human and physical features and comparing this to the city of Norwich. In science this term, the children will be exploring food chains and the life cycle of different animals. This will be linked to our whole-school focus of 'A Drop in the Ocean'.
