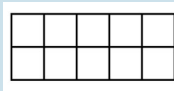




Year 1 Autumn Term 2 2020

Maths

This half term we will continue to focus on adding and subtracting numbers to 20, ensuring that children are confident recalling and using number bonds (e.g. $6+4 = 10$). We will be using tens frames and 'part-part-whole' models to do this. We will also be practising counting in 1s, 2s and 10s- it would be brilliant if you could continue to practise this at home!



English

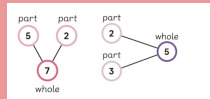
I am sure you have noticed the children becoming more confident and are really enjoying reading their Read, Write Inc Book Bag books! We will continue to use this phonics programme to support the children with their reading and writing this half term. We will be encouraging the children to remember and write dictated sentences, as well as composing their own longer sentences.



Key Vocabulary:

Maths: part, whole, addition, subtraction, total and sum.

Topic: seasons, temperature, observe, customer, past and present.



Topic

Our topic lessons this half-term will be based around two key enquiry questions:

- Where do leaves go at the end of winter?
- How have toys changed over time?

As part of this, we have a trip to the Queen's Hill Country Park planned as well as a virtual visitor linked to our toy topic!



Science

We will be thinking about what changes we can observe when the seasons change, and how the days and temperature changes with each season. The children will also be thinking about the question 'Where do leaves go at the end of Winter?'.



Music

We are a singing school so throughout the term will enjoy singing in class, especially as we prepare for our Y1 nativity. This half-term we will have weekly music sessions focusing on experimenting with and creating sounds using untuned instruments.



Sports

We will be thinking about exploring the ways our body can move in response to music. The children will think about what they are reminded of when they hear different types of music and how they can move their body to show this.

RE/RSE - We will be learning about what family and friends mean to us, how to communicate our feelings to others and to recognise how others are feeling and how to respond to them.
