Reading

Your child should be able to:

- Read and understand simple sentences e.g. 'A dog on a mat.'
- Use phonic knowledge to segment simple words and read them aloud accurately by blending the sounds together e.g "p-i-g pig."
- Read some common irregular words e.g. the, they, I, of.
- Explain to others about what they have read.



Writing

Your child should be able to:

- Use their knowledge of sounds to write words in ways which match their spoken sounds.
- Write some irregular common words e.g. the, I, of etc.
- Write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others. Some words are spelt correctly and others sound like they are spelt.
