Maths

27th Feb - Purple Mash 2Do: Name 2D shapes - pairs matching game where children have to match the images of 2D shapes with the correct names

12th March - Purple Mash 2Do: 3D shapes - quiz style activity where children need to correctly identify 3D shapes and then write (accurately) their names. This activity is timed.

26th March - Purple Mash 2Do: Estimate angles - quiz style activity where children need to estimate the size of angles by selecting from five options. This activity is timed.

EASTER: **By 23rd April** - Purple Mash 2Do: Quadrilaterals - choose six quadrilaterals and describe their properties, this could make reference to sides, vertices, angles, symmetry and/or parallel lines. Use full sentences.
