



## Year 3 Home Learning Spring Term 1 2020

The expectation is that every pupil will complete their weekly home learning tasks including Read for a Star and Marvellous Maths.

Reading diaries are due on a Monday and home learning is due on a Wednesday.

Homework Club is available for year 3 pupils on Monday's from 3-4pm. Lunchtime homework club will be available for any year 3 pupil to attend. The following teachers will host lunchtime homework club from 12-12.20 on the following days:

### Reading

Children will be set a short text to read each week. There will be four questions to answer (retrieval, inference, vocabulary and author's choice). This short text will be studied in reading sessions the following week with a focus on inference style questions.

- Retrieval: to select information directly from a text to answer a question.
- Inference: use evidence provided by the author to reach a conclusion or assumption.
- Author's choice: to discuss why the author has chosen to use a specific feature.
- Vocabulary: define words from the text and choose and identify synonyms (similar words) and antonyms (words that mean the opposite).

### Handwriting

Year 3 are focusing on joining their handwriting this term. Weekly handwriting tasks will be set as part of home learning. Every child should be able to form their letters correctly, write them in equal size and use the cursive handwriting style to be able to work at the year 3 writing expectations.

### Read for a Star

If you read 4 days a week, you will receive a Queen's Hill Reading Star. This could include reading some of a bedtime story, visiting the library, listening to an audio book or reading with a sibling.

### Marvellous Maths

Complete 4 maths activities a week to receive a Marvellous Maths Stamp. This could include a maths game on a computer or worksheets from your teacher.
