

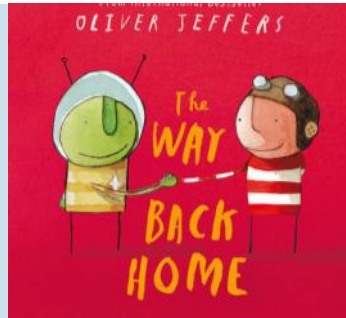


Year 1 Spring Term 2 2020

English

In maths the children will be learning the following:

- Multiplication, looking at doubling and halving numbers

Topic - My Place in The World

We will be exploring what life is like in Antarctica. The children will find out what animals live there, how people survive the cold environment and discover more about the Scott's expedition of 1911.



Science

We will be finding out about which animals live in Antarctica and finding out how they have adapted to survive in such a cold environment. We will also look at the different classifications of animals including fish, mammals and birds.



Art and Music

This half-term, we will develop our collage skills as we create an arctic landscape using paint and tissue paper. In design technology, we will practise paper folding skills to create igloos.



Sports

In PE this term, we will be working on our coordination and ball movement skills.



RE / RSE

In RE we'll be finding out how Christians use symbols to express religious beliefs. We'll also be discussing the importance of respecting others even if they make different choices or have different beliefs.
