



Read Write Inc (RWI) Phonics

RWI introduces the children to 44 different speech sounds. The children are learning set 1 sounds which are listed below. Inside this leaflet you will find the rhymes for each letter which we teach the children as they write so that you can support your child at home. Stretchy sounds (we stretch the sound):

We introduce the children to green words - these are words that we can sound out using the speech sounds above as they learn the sounds e.g. "c-a-t", "d-o-g".

They will be learning some red words which are words we cannot sound out. When reading red words we tell the

children the word e.g. "the" and look for the tricky letter in the word together "e".
