English


This half-term we will be continuing daily Read Write Inc. sound lessons on YouTube to help every child gain confidence in reading.

During writing lessons, we will be inspired through reading a different book every Monday. From this, we will be completing writing activities based on the book. We will also be doing daily spelling and handwriting videos for you to join in with on Seesaw.

Maths

This half-term we'll be learning about:

- Fractions of shapes and numbers
- Using place value to compare two-digit numbers
- Telling the time to the nearest half-hour on an analogue clock
- Recognising coins and their value.
- How to add different coins together and order them from smallest to largest



Key Vocabulary: industry, engineer, railway, growth, mindset, healthy, roots, stem, petal, leaves, bud, o'clock, half past, pounds, pence

Topic

This term our whole school topic is growth. We will be finding out about how we grow and what we can do to stay fit and healthy. We'll also be learning about the work of Isambard Brunel, whose inventions helped to shape the face of Britain.



Science

We will be learning about how plants grow and what they need to live. Alongside this, we will be naming common garden plants like beans and daffodils as well as labelling and naming parts of plants.



Art

We'll be learning about the work of artists Jasper Johns and Patrick Heron. Mr. Cross will also be continuing with his regular drawing lessons for you to enjoy at home.



Sports

This term we will be continuing to keep fit with Joe Wicks in the mornings. You might also want to join in with Cosmic Kids Yoga in the afternoon for some relaxation at the end of the day.



RE/RSE

In RE we will be finding out about Shabbat, the Jewish day of rest. In RSE we will be exploring different ways to ask for help from others.
