



Year 2 Summer Term 1 2020

English

This half-term we will be continuing daily Read Write Inc. sound lessons on YouTube to help every child gain confidence in reading.

During writing lessons, we will be inspired through reading a different book every Monday. From this, we will be completing writing activities based on the book.

We will be reading 'Home', 'How to catch a star', 'I will not ever never eat a tomato', 'The dot' and 'Percy the park keeper after the storm'.



Maths

This half term, we will be revising what we have learnt so far in Year 2. We will begin by recapping place value and how this can help us add and subtract two-digit numbers.

We will be learning how to use our knowledge of multiplication and division to solve word problems. Through mathematical investigations, we will revise our knowledge of fractions.



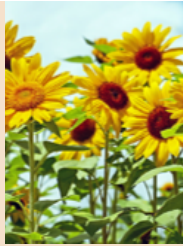
Topic

Science












News
