

Year 6 Social Story: My Day in School



I will come into school via the **Stockwell Road** gate. I walk straight from home to school.



The fences have been marked at 2m intervals so that I can queue for the gate to get into school whilst keeping my distance from others.



I will walk across the playground to get to my classroom pod. I will go straight to my pod.



I will hang up my coat and bag on the back of my chair inside the classroom.



If I have to bring a phone to school, it will be turned off at the school gate. It will stay in my backpack and I bring it in at my own risk.



I will wash my hands each day when I arrive at school for 20 seconds. I will wash my hands every time I come in from playing outside. I will wash my hands before eating.



This is what my pod might look like.



I will only sit next to someone at a table if they are my twin.



I will eat my snack in my pod. I will bring a snack to school with me if I think I'll get hungry before 1pm (our new lunchtime).



I will eat my lunch in the pod I am learning in. Lunch will be at 1pm.



This is the playground space where I will play outside each day. I will need a hat and should arrive at school wearing sun cream. I will need a jacket if it is cooler or wet.



We will keep the doors and windows open each day, but I must stay outside or inside with the adult looking after me. If it's not sunny, I should remember to have a jacket and my jumper in case it gets chilly inside.



I will do some outdoor learning sometimes. I must play with children from my pod within the boundaries of the cones, so that everyone can keep safe.



I will put any tissues I use in the blue bin.



When I need the toilet, I will ask an adult. I will go on my own, keeping a distance from anyone I may pass in the corridor. I will queue outside the door in the corridor if there is someone inside already.



At the end of the school day, I will leave the school site immediately and walk straight home, keeping a distance from others.
