


NEWSLETTER NOVEMBER 2020



As I write this we are awaiting to see if the country goes into another lockdown on Thursday. From a school's point of view nothing much will change, as far as we are aware. We find out about the changes when you do - we don't get a heads up!

The teachers continue to plan for remote learning alongside face to face learning for those children who are having to self isolate due to awaiting medical procedures or because the family has been contacted by Test and Trace. Even if the country goes into a second lockdown the current aim is that all children should be in school unless they are ill or self isolating. We are anticipating that at some stage a whole class or year group will have to self isolate and in this situation the whole class will move to remote learning. We are able to provide paper packs to those who need it (please request these using the office@queenshill.norfolk.sch.uk

To help us to protect our staff and you, the community, we ask that you continue to adhere to social distancing guidance and collect and move on as quickly as possible at the end of the day. Our staff will be wearing facemasks outside when parents/carers are onsite and you may wish to wear a facemask too.

We will continue to adhere to a strict hygiene regime at school, keep the classes separate unless we need to treat a year group as a bubble for staffing/curriculum needs and keep occupied spaces well ventilated.

The outside will be used regularly and so we do recommend, as per government guidance, that pupils come to school in more layers than they might usually eg thermal vests, thick woolly, hats etc

We will keep you updated with any changes as they occur. Do please keep an eye on the school website, emails and text messages.

To date, we have had no staff or pupils with a positive test result. We are doing everything we can to ensure that your child/ren enjoy a full curriculum whilst adhering to the government guidance... filming for our Christmas productions has already started!

The Warm House Discount Scheme



You could get £140 off your electricity bill for winter 2020 to 2021 under the Warm Home Discount Scheme.

The money is not paid to you - it's a one-off discount on your electricity bill, between September and March.

You may be able to get the discount on your gas bill instead if your supplier provides you with both gas and electricity. Contact your supplier to find out.

Following a review of our risk assessments, Key Stage 2 pupils who receive hot dinners will start to collect their meals from the hall using a one-way, one-class system from 2nd November. This is part of a pilot and will be reviewed regularly.



Free School Meals

As the current Covid-19 pandemic continues to affect us, it is possible that if your circumstances have changed you could be entitled to free school meals for your child/children. This could save you over £350 per year. During the March lockdown we were still able to provide hot dinners for collection each day for FSM children and that FSM families also received a voucher to spend in the supermarkets for the summer holidays too. Dependent upon your family circumstances, your son/daughter may be entitled to a free school meal every day. If this is the case, the local authority has funds allocated for this purpose.
