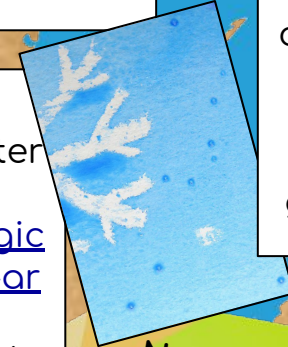
Learn how to tie dye using kitchen paper and food colouring with Miss Butcher on the school YouTube channel.
