Our Learning

We have continued phonics this week and have learnt the sounds d, t, i and n.

In maths we are working on recognising 4 without counting, this is called subitising. We have been looking at whether there are 4 or not 4 items.

In topic we have been talking about jobs that people have and what we would like to be when we grow up.

Independent Skill of the Week

This week we have been working on putting our coat on independently. Some children prefer using the montessori coat flip, so you may want to google this.

Home Learning Ideas

Literacy- Play Simon Says using fred talk. Fred speaks in sounds, use this for the last word of the sentence: 'touch your ch-i-n'.

These ideas are completely optional but can be used as your Marvellous Maths or reading activity for the week.
