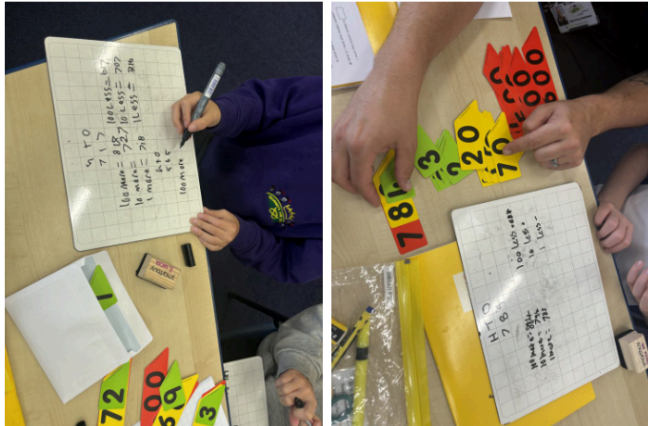


# Curriculum Newsletter

- **17th December** KS2 Christmas Dinner

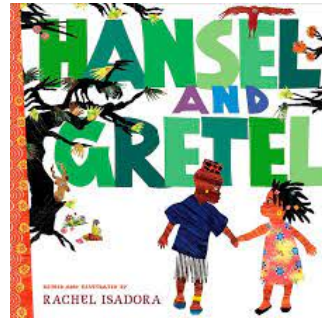
## Key vocabulary
